## RAINIERS NOTES

Class in Session: Pro Football Hall of Fame writer John Clayton will provide play-by-play and color commentary alongside Mike Curto for the next three games ( $7 / 21,7 / 22$, and $7 / 23$ ). Clayton can be seen on ESPN's SportsCenter, NFL Countdown, and NFL Live or heard on The John Clayton Show on 710 ESPN Seattle radio.

Career Oriented: Designated hitter Jeff Clement slug ranks fourth in the PCL with 27 doubles. Clement has slugged 89 doubles over his Tacoma career, which ranks third among Tacoma ballplayers behind teammate Bryan LaHair (98) and Dan Rohrmeier (94). Additionally, Clement ranks seventh among Tacoma career batting leaders with 51 home runs.

Speed + Power = Success: Leadoff hitter Jerry Owens has clobbered three triples and batted .548 (17x31) over his active seven-game hit streak. Owens has batted .434/.464/.604 (23×53) and collected multiple hits in eight of 13 games this July. Owens leads the Rainiers in batting average (.307) and stolen bases (12). The base stolen by Owens last night was his first since $6 / 26$ - a stretch of 16 games.

Handle with Care: The Rainiers are tied with the Las Vegas 51s for the league lead in home runs (105). Tacoma has five batters that have hit 10 or more home runs this season: Bryan LaHair (17), Jeff Clement (13), Prentice Redman (13), Michael Saunders (12), and Mike Carp (10). Chris Shelton currently with the Seattle Mariners - has also hit 12 home runs for Tacoma this season.

Triumphant Return: Third baseman Matt Tuiasosopo has reached base safely in each of his first four games since returning to action from the disabled list. Additionally, Tuiasosopo has hit two doubles and one home run in those four games. Tuiasosopo has batted $.188 / .350 / .500$ over those four games.

Punishing Pitchers: Outfielder Michael Saunders has batted .500 ( $8 \times 16$ ) over his current four-game hit streak, including two doubles, one home run, three runs, and one RBI. Saunders has registered multiple hits in three of those four games. Saunders has batted $.364 / .417 / .667$ through his first nine games of July.

From Top to Bottom: Seven Rainiers have collected 50 or more hits this season: Jeff Clement (97), Prentice Redman (85), Bryan LaHair (83), Michael Saunders (72), Mike Carp (72), Jerry Owens (69), and Adam Moore (58). Both Chris Shelton (96) and Chris Woodward (52) have reached the 50 -hit plateau despite currently being on assignment with the Seattle Mariners.

Here We Go Again: Designated hitter Jeff Clement has started another hit streak. Clement has batted. 333 ( $6 \times 18$ ), with one home run, two runs, and four RBI, over his burgeoning four-game hit streak. Clement had a teamhigh 20 -game hit streak from $5 / 12$ to $6 / 1$ this season.

ACQUIRED: Signed as a minor league free agent with Seattle on $5 / 2 / 09 \ldots$..efused a minor league assignment 4/29/09...signed as a minor league free agent with Washington on $11 / 17 / 07 \ldots$...drafted in the third round (81st overall) by the Anaheim Angels in the 2001 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss - his second of the season - in a 4-5 defeat at Las Vegas on 6/17...pitched to 25 batters over 5.2 IP...allowed six hits, including two doubles and a two-run home run, and five earned runs...walked two and struck out five...induced four ground outs and eight fly outs...threw 87 pitches and 57 strikes (65.5\%)

VERSUS THE RIVER CATS: This is Shell's first 2009 outing versus Sacramento.
2009: Started the season with the Washington Nationals...made four relief appearances (5.0 IP) in April with a $0-0$ record, 5.40 ERA, two walks, five strikeouts, and .250 batting average...debuted with the Rainiers on $5 / 5 \ldots$ made 16 relief appearances with Tacoma before being assigned to AA West Tennessee...predictably dominated AA competition in the Southern League...went 3-0 with a 0.43 ERA, six walks, and 16 strikeouts, and .123 batting average in five relief appearances (21.0 IP) at West Tennessee.

2008: Made his MLB debut with Washington on 6/22...finished the season with Washington and appeared in 39 games...went 2-2 with 2 saves, 2.16 ERA, .194 batting average, 20 walks, and 41 strikeouts in 50.0 IP at the major league level...earned his first MLB save $7 / 11 \mathrm{vs}$. Houston and first MLB win $8 / 30$ vs. Atlanta...first MLB save is the longest in Washington history (1.2 IP)...spent the first three months of the season with AAA Columbus of the International League...made 22 appearances, including four consecutive starts ( $5 / 5,5 / 10,5 / 15$, and $5 / 20$ )...went $1-1$ in those starts...was $3-2$ with a 2.62 ERA and .231 batting average in 50.0 IP at Columbus...did not allow a run in his final eight AAA appearances, from $5 / 30$ to 6/19.

2007: Spent the season with the AAA Salt Lake Bees of the Pacific Coast League...won four straight decisions from $5 / 13$ to $6 / 20 \ldots$ had a 3.48 ERA at home and a 5.89 ERA on the road...was a member of Team USA in the 2007 Baseball World Cup.
