RAINIERS NOTES

Impact Player: Mike Wilson has been hit by a pitch in each of his last three games and hit by four pitches in his last five games. Wilson, now hit by pitch five times in 21 games, was welcomed to the PCL when he was hit by pitch in his first game with the Rainiers on 7/27. Wilson is on pace to be plunked 34 times over the course of a 144-game season. Matt Tuiasosopo led the 2008 Rainiers in hit by pitch with 12.

Back for More: Brad Nelson has tallied five runs, five RBI, and eight total bases over his last two games. Nelson has hit home runs in both of his last two games. Nelson is the only Rainiers batter to have slugged home runs in three consecutive nights this season – and he has done it twice: from 7/2 to 7/4 and 7/24 to 7/26. Nelson's pinch hit home run of 8/17 and his grand slam of 8/18 were both hit in the first pitch of each respective at bat.

Show of Force: Mike Carp has reached base safely in each of his last seven games and has recorded a hit in each of his last five games. Carp has batted .368 (7x19) with one triple, two home runs, three runs, and two RBI over that five-game hit streak. That triple is the first of the season for Carp and his first since 8/1/08. Interestingly, both of Carp's last two triples came in games in which he played left field. The natural first baseman has batted only .150 (6x40) this season as a left fielder, but five of those six hits have gone for extra bases: four doubles and one triple. Carp has claimed 14 total bases over his last three games.

The Consummate Professional: Chris Shelton has batted .429 (7x17) with two runs and three RBI over his current five-game hit streak. Shelton has not batted under .300 in any month since April: .398 (37x93) in May, .317 (9x29) in June, .310 (9x29) in July, and .333 (10x30) in August. Shelton has collected six walks and only one strikeout over nine games this August.

Lockdown: Brandon Morrow has been downright miserly throughout August, and especially at Cheney Stadium. Morrow has earned a 2-0 record with a 1.23 ERA (3 ER/22 IP), thirteen strikeouts, three walks, 15 strikeouts, and .203 batting average over three starts this month. Additionally, Morrow has amassed a 2-0 record with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER/20.2 IP) and .218 batting average over three starts at Cheney Stadium. Morrow has allowed two or less earned runs in four of his six starts with the Rainiers.

Finish What You Start: Randy Messenger has closed in on the Tacoma single season record for saves. Messenger has 25 saves this season, which ranks third among Tacoma single season performances. Todd Williams recorded 32 saves for the Rainiers in 2000, and Joe Bitker recorded 29 saves for the Tacoma Tigers in 1990. Messenger ranks second in the PCL in saves, behind Albuquerque's Brian Strickland (27). Messenger's teammate, Jared Wells, led the PCL in saves in 2008 with 20.

ACQUIRED: Drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the first round – fifth overall selection – in the 2006 draft...selected by the Anaheim Angels in the 40th round (1200th overall) in the 2003 draft

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season with a complete game shutout of the Iowa Cubs on 8/14...needed only 96 pitches and 59 strikes to go through 31 batters in 9.0 innings...allowed four hits, including one double...walked one and struck out two...induced 12 ground outs and 13 fly outs...was the second Tacoma complete game shutout of the month (and second of the year): Andy Baldwin accomplished shutout the Express on 8/5 at Round Rock.

VERSUS THE ROYALS: This is Morrow's first 2009 outing versus the Royals.

2009: Started 2009 with the Seattle Mariners...made 22 appearances and six starts...accumulated an 0-4 record with six saves in eight opportunities with Seattle...5.28 ERA (27 ER/46.0 IP) with Seattle, including 31 walks and 45 strikeouts...saved four consecutive games from 4/17 to 5/10...converted to rotation on 6/13...went 0-1 with a 4.55 ERA (14 ER/27.2 IP) as a starter for Seattle...optioned to Tacoma on 7/11...struggled with Tacoma in July with a 0-2 record and 8.56 ERA (13 ER/13.2 IP), but has been stellar in August with a 2-0 record, 1.23 ERA (3 ER/22 IP), thirteen strikeouts, three walks, 15 strikeouts, and .203 batting average over three starts...performs well at Cheney Stadium with 2-0 record and 1.31 ERA (3 ER/20.2 IP) over three starts...has allowed two or less earned runs in four of his six starts with Tacoma.

2008: Made 45 appearances and five starts for Seattle...went 3-4 with 10 saves and a 3.34 ERA (24 ER/64.2 IP)...earned a 1.47 ERA (6 ER/36.2 IP) as a reliever...that relief ERA ranked second-lowest in Seattle Mariners history, trailing only RHP J.J. Putz (1.38 in 2007)...made first Major League start in 101st appearance, 9/5 vs. New York...allowed one hit, one run and struck out 9 in 7.2 innings...no-hit the Yankees through 7.2 innings...earned first career save 6/11 at Toronto...was 8x8 in save opportunities to open the season...optioned to Tacoma (AAA) on 8/5 to begin transition to starting pitcher...made 5 starts for the Rainiers, going 1-1 with a 3.37 ERA (7 ER/18.2 IP)...opened the season at West Tennessee (AA).

PERSONAL: Brandon John Morrow...attended Rancho Cotate High School in Rohnert Park, California and University of California Berkeley in Berkeley, CA...diagnosed as a Type 1 diabetic his senior year of high school...wears an insulin pump to regulate blood sugar levels.
