RAINIERS NOTES

One Man Wrecking Crew: Jerry Owens became the first Rainiers batter to register six hits in one game since Pat Borders at Colorado Springs on 5/8/03. Owens hit two triples and scored five runs last night, en route to a thrilling 11-9 extra innings victory. Additionally, Owens has reached base safely in each of his last seven games. Owens has batted .485 (16x33) with one double, two triples, one home run, 12 runs, four RBI, five walks, and three stolen bases over that seven-game span.

One-Two Combination: Leadoff man Jerry Owens isn't the only Rainier causing havoc. Matt Tuiasosopo has reached base safely in each of his last seven games. Tuiasosopo has batted .333 (10x30) with two doubles, two home runs, 10 runs, three RBI, and six walks over that span. Tuiasosopo has collected multiple hits in four of those seven games.

Power Surge: Prentice Redman has batted .474 (9x19) with three doubles, three home runs, six runs, and seven RBI over his current five-game hit streak. Redman started that hit streak with one double each of the first three games. Redman has also hit one home run in each of his last two games, including a pinch-hit home run last night.

Driving it Home: Mike Carp has batted .615 (8x13) with nine RBI over his budding three-game hit streak. Carp has batted .386 (17x44) with three home runs, six runs, and 12 RBI over his last 10 games.

Not Just Leather: Oswaldo Navarro has batted .333 (6x18) with one double, three runs, and two RBI over his current four-game hit streak. That hit streak is his longest of the season.

Well Adjusted: Andy Baldwin has allowed only two hits and one earned run in his first three relief appearances. Baldwin has walked none and struck out two in 3.2 innings of relief work in those three games.

Lone Lefty: Justin Thomas, the only southpaw in the bullpen, has earned a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/6.0 IP) over his last five appearances. Thomas has allowed only one hit and one walk as he has struck out three over those five games. Thomas has held opponents to a .100 batting average (2x20) over that span.

Souvenir Cities: The Rainiers have hit 83 home runs over 67 road games this season. Those 80 home runs have generated 128 of the team's 372 runs scored on the road – 34.4% of all run production. The Rainiers have hit 14 home runs in 11 games versus Portland this season.

In Good Company: The next home run Bryan LaHair hits will tie him for ninth among Tacoma single season batting leaders. Bucky Jacobsen (26) and A.J. Zapp (29) both earned indelible records on that list in 2004. LaHair became the Tacoma career leader in doubles this season.

Triage: Infielder Alex Cintrón has been placed on the disabled list. Infielder Erick Monzón has been activated from the disabled list.

ACQUIRED: Traded from Chicago (NL) with Ronny Cedeno in exchange for Aaron Heilman on January 28, 2009...Part of two offseason trades...acquired by Chicago (NL) for Felix Pie on January 18, 2009...traded to Seattle ten-days later...Baltimore's 2nd selection (sandwich pick) in the 2005 First Year Player Draft; 48th selection overall...that draft choice was compensation for failure to sign RHP Wade Townsend; first round selection in the 2004 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned no decision in a 8-9 defeat versus Omaha on 8/21, his first AAA action since 4/30...threw 74 pitches and 45 strikes to 24 batters over 4.0 innings...allowed eight earned runs on 10 hits, including two doubles and two home runs...walked two and struck out two...threw one wild pitch...hit one batsman...induced six ground outs and four fly outs.

VERSUS THE BEAVERS: This is Olson's first 2009 outing versus the Beavers.

2009: Struck out nine batters in 11.1 IP at 2009 spring training...went 2-2 with 3.08 ERA (9 ER/26.1 IP) in five starts (all in April) with Tacoma...held AAA batters to a .138 batting average...has not allowed more than four hits or three runs with Tacoma...struck out six twice...recalled to Seattle on 5/6...went 3-5 with a 5.88 ERA (49 ER/75.0 IP) in 24 games and 11 starts with Seattle...earned a 6.49 ERA (38 ER/52.2 IP) as a starter and a 4.43 ERA (11 ER/22.1 IP) as a reliever...held MLB batters to a .263 batting average...went 3-1 with a 4.94 ERA (13 ER/23.2 IP), .225 batting average, five walks, and 11 strikeouts over 7 games in June with Seattle.

2008: went 1-1 with 1.85 ERA in five April starts at Norfolk (AAA)...Recalled to Baltimore on April 29, 2008...went 9-10 with a 6.65 ERA in 26 starts for the Orioles...ranked 4th among AL rookies in starts (26), 5th in wins (9), 5th in innings pitched (132.2), and 6th in strikeouts (83)...started the season 5-1 with a 3.86 ERA (19 ER, 44.1 IP) through his first eight MLB starts...pitched a career-best 8.1 IP with 3 ER on 11 hits August 1, 2008 at Seattle...struck out a career-best 7 batters May 5, 2008 at Oakland.
