### RAINIERS NOTES

**Momentum:** The Rainiers have outscored opponents 37-22, batted .289 (67x232), held opponents to a .241 batting average (53x220), and scored eight doubles, three triples, and 10 home runs over their current season-high six-game win streak.

**Here I Come to Save the Day:** Robert Manuel has recorded three saves in three opportunities over the current six-game win streak. Manuel has earned a 1.58 ERA (1 ER/5.2 IP) and .211 opponents' batting average (5x19) in four appearances over the win streak. Manuel has allowed only one run in his last nine appearances (12.0 IP).

**Offensive Catalyst:** Owens has reached base safely in each of his last nine games. Owens has batted .429 (18x42) with two doubles, two triples, one home run, 12 runs, four RBI, six walks, and three stolen bases over that nine-game span. Owens has batted .348 (16x46) with three doubles, two triples, six runs, one RBI, and five walks in 11 games versus Portland this season.

**Unstoppable Juggernaut:** Oswaldo Navarro has batted .360 (9x25) with one double, four runs, and three RBI over his current six-game hit streak. Navarro has doubled his total number of extra base hits, doubled his total number of hit-by-pitch, and tallied three of his five multiple-hit games over that six-game streak. That streak represents the longest hit streak for Navarro since another six-game hit streak this season at AA West Tennessee from 5/15 to 5/21.

**On a Mission:** Mike Carp has batted .455 (10x22) with one double, one home run, three runs, and 10 RBI over his five-game hit streak. Carp's longest hit streak this season occurred from 4/24 to 5/1. Carp batted .448 (13x29) with two doubles, three home runs, nine runs, and six RBI over that seven-game span. Carp has registered 28 hits and 22 RBI in 25 August games, his highest monthly totals of the season.

**Birthday Bashing:** Prentice Redman has batted .455 (10x22) with three doubles, three home runs, seven runs, and seven RBI over his current six-game hit streak. Redman started that hit streak with one double each of the first three games. Redman has also hit one home run in two consecutive games, one of those a pinch-hit home run. Redman turned 30-years old on the third game of that streak, 8/23.

**Well-Adjusted:** Andy Baldwin has allowed only two hits and one earned run in his first three relief appearances. Baldwin has walked none and struck out two in 3.2 innings of relief work over those three games.

**Pelting the Beavers:** The Rainiers are 10-3 versus the Beavers this season. Tacoma batters have slugged 24 doubles, five triples, and 15 home runs in those 13 games, while Tacoma pitchers have walked only 32 and struck out 86 Beavers batters in 117.0 innings of play.

**ACQUIRED:** Traded to Seattle Mariners from the Florida Marlins in exchange for Arthur Rhodes on 7/31/2008...acquired by Florida Marlins from New York Mets with outfielder Dante Brinkley in exchange for catcher Paul Lo Duca on 12/9/2005...selected by the New York Mets in the fourth round of the 2004 draft, 74th overall selection.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned second consecutive win in a 10-5 victory at Fresno on 8/23...threw 93 pitches and 53 strikes to 26 batters over 6.0 innings...allowed two earned runs on five hits, including one double and two solo home runs...walked two and struck out four...induced six ground outs and eight fly outs...hit one batsman, his 10th of the season.

**VERSUS THE BEAVERS:** This is Hernandez's first 2009 versus the Beavers.

**2009:** Snapped team-high 10-game winless streak on 8/2; 0-7 with 7.36 ERA (42 ER/51.1 IP) over that span...won three straight appearances in May; 2.75 ERA (5 ER/16.1 IP)...lost a team-high four consecutive appearances in June; 6.85 ERA (16 ER/21 IP)...3-2 with a 3.22 ERA (13 ER/36.1 IP) and .235 batting average in May...struck out a season high eight (in 5.0 IP) versus Reno on 6/19...has incurred only five unearned runs this season and none since 6/25...has not lost a game since 7/28 at Reno.

**2008:** Started 2008 with AAA Albuquerque...made 13 starts for the Isotopes, went 2-8, 7.24 (52 ER, 64.2 IP)...lost five consecutive decisions (5/31 - 7/4)...on the disabled list with a strained left oblique muscle (4/23 - 5/19)...transferred to Carolina (AA) on 7/6, winning three of four starts (3-0, 4.30)...traded to Seattle and assigned to West Tennessee (AA)...went 1-0, 2.45 (4 ER, 14.2 IP) with 11 strikeouts over final three starts...played for the Peoria Javelinas in the Arizona Fall League...went 2-5, 7.67 in eight starts.
