RAINIERS NOTES

Race to the Finish: The Rainiers have outscored opponents 53-27 and scored 15 doubles, three triples, and 14 home runs over their current nine-game win streak. The Rainiers were 15-2 on the road this month and gained 7.5 games in the last nine days. Tacoma is tied for the division lead with Colorado Springs. Colorado Springs visits Tacoma for the final four games of the regular season, from 9/4 to 9/7. The Rainiers have not owned a share of first place since 4/20, after the 12th game of season – 124 games ago.

Long Ball Kings: The Rainiers lead all of minor league baseball with 162 home runs. The Rainiers have nine current or former players that have slugged 10 or more home runs this season: Carp (15), Clement (14), LaHair (25), Morse (10), Nelson (15), Redman (20), Saunders (13), Shelton (14), and Tuiasosopo (10). Fellow Seattle Mariners affiliate, the High Desert Mavericks of the California League, have slugged the second-most home runs in minor league baseball. The Mayericks have scored 154 home runs this season.

Clutch Performance: Oswaldo Navarro has been a man possessed over his current nine-game hit streak. Navarro has batted .412 (14x34) with two doubles, seven runs, and four RBI over that nine-game hit streak. That nine-game hit streak is his longest since a nine-game hit streak with Tacoma from 5/4/08 to 5/12/08. Navarro has raised his batting average 66 points over the last nine games, from .147 to .213.

Everywhere at Once: Matt Tuiasosopo has reached base safely in 12 consecutive games and recorded a hit in each of his last four games. Tuiasosopo has batted .308 (16x52) with four doubles, four home runs, 12 runs, seven RBI, and nine walks in those 12 games. Tuiasosopo has batted .333 (6x18) with two doubles, two home runs, two runs, and four RBI over the four-game hit streak. Tuiasosopo has registered hits in nine of those 12 games and tallied six walks in the three hitless games.

Free Range: Jerry Owens has reached safely in 11 consecutive games. Owens has batted .375 (18x48) with two doubles, two triples, one home run, 15 runs, four RBI, and three stolen bases over that span. Additionally, Owens has failed to register a hit in only three of those 11 games, yet he has earned seven walks in those three hitless games.

Veteran Stability: Prentice Redman has reached base safely in each of his last eight games. Redman has batted .464 (13x28) with four doubles, four home runs, 12 runs, 10 RBI, and five walks over that span. Redman hit 19 home runs in 82 games with Tacoma last season and 20 home runs in 101 games with Tacoma this season.

Coming Alive: Mike Wilson has reached base safely in each of his last five games. Wilson has batted .278 (5x18) with two home runs, three runs, two RBI, and three walks over that span. Wilson has hit all five of his home runs this season in his last 11 games.

ACQUIRED: Traded from Chicago (NL) with Ronny Cedeno in exchange for Aaron Heilman on January 28, 2009...Part of two offseason trades...acquired by Chicago (NL) for Felix Pie on January 18, 2009...traded to Seattle ten-days later...Baltimore's 2nd selection (sandwich pick) in the 2005 First Year Player Draft; 48th selection overall...that draft choice was compensation for failure to sign RHP Wade Townsend; first round selection in the 2004 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned second consecutive no decision in a 2-1 victory at Portland on 8/26...threw 96 pitches and 60 strikes to 24 batters over 6.0 innings...allowed one earned run on four hits, three singles and one double...walked three and struck out a season high seven...induced four ground outs and six fly outs...allowed two stolen bases and caught one stealing, with catcher Jamie Burke.

VERSUS THE BEES: This is Olson's first 2009 outing versus the Bees.

2009: Struck out nine batters in 11.1 IP at 2009 spring training...went 2-2 with 3.08 ERA (9 ER/26.1 IP) in five starts (all in April) with Tacoma...held AAA batters to a .138 batting average...has not allowed more than four hits or three runs with Tacoma...struck out six twice...recalled to Seattle on 5/6...went 3-5 with a 5.88 ERA (49 ER/75.0 IP) in 24 games and 11 starts with Seattle...earned a 6.49 ERA (38 ER/52.2 IP) as a starter and a 4.43 ERA (11 ER/22.1 IP) as a reliever...held MLB batters to a .263 batting average...went 3-1 with a 4.94 ERA (13 ER/23.2 IP), .225 batting average, five walks, and 11 strikeouts over seven games in June with Seattle...suffered his worst AAA outing of the season in his return to Tacoma on 8/21: season high 10 hits, season high eight earned runs, and season low two strikeouts...rebounded in his next outing: four hits, one earn run, and season high seven strikeouts.

2008: went 1-1 with 1.85 ERA in five April starts at Norfolk (AAA)...Recalled to Baltimore on April 29, 2008...went 9-10 with a 6.65 ERA in 26 starts for the Orioles...ranked 4th among AL rookies in starts (26), 5th in wins (9), 5th in innings pitched (132.2), and 6th in strikeouts (83)...started the season 5-1 with a 3.86 ERA (19 ER, 44.1 IP) through his first eight MLB starts...pitched a career-best 8.1 IP with 3 ER on 11 hits August 1, 2008 at Seattle...struck out a career-best 7 batters May 5, 2008 at Oakland.
